## 2007 OARS INVITATIONAL REGATTA



### March 24, 2007 Bill Fredrick Park at Turkey Lake, Orlando

OARS is pleased to be hosting the 2007 OARS Invitational Regatta on Saturday, March 24, 2007. We invite you to join us for an exciting day of racing. Please read through this packet and make yourself aware of all the entry information & changes that are in effect for this years racing.

**Venue Information:** Bill Fredrick Park is located at 3140 Hiawassee Road, Orlando, Florida 32835; phone # 407-299-5594. There will be a \$4 per vehicle fee to enter the park and \$30 per bus. There will be ample vehicle parking available. Parking for busses & spectators will be in the softball field at the east end of the park. Parking for boat trailers will be on the southeast side of the spectator parking area. Boat trailer parking will be available in the designated areas beginning March  $23^{rd}$  from 3:00 - 6:00 p.m. The gated entrance to the park is locked at 6:00 p.m. It is recommended that the trailers arrive at the site on Friday afternoon to avoid traffic and congestion on Saturday morning.

#### **Directions:**

From Tampa: I-4 East toward Orlando. Exit Sand Lake Rd. & turn left at the ramp. Go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> light which is Turkey Lake Rd., turn right on Turkey Lake Rd. and follow 3-4 miles until it intersects with Conroy-Windermere Rd. Turn left on Conroy-Windermere. Go approximately ½ mile to the intersections of Hiawassee Rd. Turn right on Hiawassee. Go approximately ¾ mile on Hiawassee. Bill Fredrick Park is on your right.

*From Miami*: I-95 north to the Beeline Expressway/Rt. 528 West (tollway). Follow the signs to I-4 East towards Orlando. The first exit after merging on to I-4 is Sand Lake Road. Exit Sand Lake Rd. & turn left at the ramp. Go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> light which is Turkey Lake Rd., turn right on Turkey Lake Rd. and follow 3-4 miles until it intersects with Conroy-Windermere Rd. Turn left on Conroy-Windermere. Go approximately ½ mile to the intersections of Hiawassee Rd. Turn right on Hiawassee. Go approximately ¾ mile on Hiawassee. Turkey Lake Park is on your right.

From Orlando & North: I-4 West. Exit on Conroy-Windermere Rd. Go straight on Conroy-Windermere through 4 traffic lights, the 5<sup>th</sup> light is Hiawassee. Turn right on Hiawassee. Go approximately <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile on Hiawassee. Turkey Lake Park is on your right.

**Friday Practice:** The course will be open on Friday, March 23rd from 3:30 - 5:30 p.m. with all teams needing to exit by 6:00 p.m. Please e-mail us ahead of time to let us know if you are planning on attending this practice.

<u>Concessions</u>: Concessions will be available. All concessions & vendors must be permitted through the city of Orlando & approved by OARS.

<u>Registration</u>: Registration will open at 6:30 a.m. at the pavilion near the launching docks. Please check in at registration before the coaches & coxswain meeting. **ABSOLUTELY NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE ON RACE DAY – except for scratches with a \$25.00 scratch fee for each boat scratched.** 

<u>Accommodations</u>: Primitive cabins, which accommodate groups of up to 10 people, are available for rent at TLP. Call TLP to arrange for rental. Overnight camping is also available in the park on a first come, first serve basis. There are a number of hotels in the area. You may call any major hotel chain & ask for hotels near Universal Studios or Sea World.

**Entries:** Your registration must be submitted on <u>www.regattacentral.com</u> by **Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup>**. No late entries will be allowed.

Your registration must include the following. Any team not including all 3 items, will not be entered into any races:

- ➤ On-line entry form
- ➤ Waivers (use the USRowing waiver)
- > Entry Fees
- > \$1.00 Insurance Fee per rower

**Entry fees:** Eights - \$80.00; Fours - \$60.00; Quads - \$50.00; Doubles - \$40.00; Singles - \$25.00; \$1.00 Insurance Fee per rower; Fee Cap - \$700.00

**Scratch fees:** Each entry scratched after Wednesday, March 21<sup>st</sup> will be given a \$25.00 scratch fee per boat.

**<u>Doubling:</u>** Doubling is allowed at this regatta, but we ask that you try to limit races to 2 per individual. We ask that you limit the amount of doubling in novice, freshman, 3<sup>rd</sup>, & JV level events to ensure that we can complete the entire race day (rowers shouldn't be rowing 3 or 4 times)! Coxswains may be doubled as much as you want! Rowers who are doubled will not be given consideration for hot-seating.

<u>Multiple entries:</u> Each team shall enter no more than one crew per event. **There are no "B" boat entries** with the exception of sculling events.

# of Flights: With the # of teams participating and being allowed to double, the number of flights in each event will be limited to ensure racing is completed before 6p.m. The following categories will be limited to no more than 3 or 4 flights (based on the # of overall entries received): Novice 4's, Freshman 4's, 3<sup>rd</sup> 4's and Ltwt 4's. We will fill events based on a first come – first serve basis (obviously an incentive to get your entries in early). If you are one of the later crews to enter and are not put in a flight, we will put your boat on a waiting list.

<u>Lightweight events:</u> A lightweight boy is defined as a rower with a maximum weight of 155 pounds. A lightweight girl is defined as a rower with a maximum weight of 130 pounds. Rowers must weigh in wearing race attire. No weight allowance shall be given for clothing. All rowers in a boat must weigh-in as a boat. Only one opportunity to weigh-in will be allowed.

<u>Novice events:</u> A novice is a rower who began rowing no earlier than June 2006. Coxswains of novice boats must be novice coxswains.

<u>Freshmen Events:</u> All freshman are defined as rowers who are in 9<sup>th</sup> grade in high school and may include rowers in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Coxswains of freshmen boats must also be freshman.

<u>Cancellation of events:</u> Events with only one entry at the registration deadline will be eliminated and the team will be notified in advance of race day. If race day scratches reduce a race to one entry, the single entry will row down the course for time.

**<u>Flights:</u>** If there are more than 6 entries for an event, multiple flights shall be held. Flights will be seeded based on results from races up to this point.

<u>Coaches & Coxswains Meeting:</u> The coaches & coxswains meeting will be held at 7:00 a.m. on race day at the registration area. Representatives from each team must attend.

**Race information:** 1,500 meter, six lane course.

<u>Bowballs, bowmarkers & shoes:</u> No boat will be allowed on the water without a bowball & quick release shoes. Heel ties must be in place & secure. Please bring your own bow markers & place them on your boat before you launch.

<u>Cancellation due to Inclement Weather:</u> If weather prohibits racing on Saturday, Varsity events will be run first.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in each flight. An all points trophy will be awarded to the team accumulating the most points. Points will be awarded for finishing positions based upon the FSRA Youth point system.
