Stay to the north side of the row of palm trees on the right. Please do not block access to the dock.

- **BOW NUMBERS** Bow numbers are not required, but would be EXTREMELY helpful. Please bring them, if you have them.
- **SAFETY EQUIP.** Of course, all boats will be required to have bow balls and heel ties. Please check your boats prior to launching.
- **STARTING LINE** We will have a floating start. Have your athletes prepared to deal with the wind, a quick start or a countdown start.

Go about 1 mile and turn left when the road dead ends at Hwy 15a (Handy Way/Citgo/Hardees on left)

Go a 1.8 miles and turn right and go West on New York (Hwy 44)

You will see a brown sign for Hontoon Island State Park & Amtrak sign

Turn left after the sign onto Old New York (fork to the left just before train tracks)

Go about 1.8 miles (past Amtrak Station; past convenient store) and turn left onto Hontoon Rd. (you'll see the brown sign again for Hontoon Island)

Go 1.5 miles and turn left into the first driveway on the left after Hontoon Rd. makes a sharp left turn (but before Hontoon Rd. makes the sharp right turn!) and go straight onto the property.

#### FROM THE SOUTH (I-95)

Take the HWY 44 WEST exit #249 for DeLand/ New Smyrna Beach

Go 22.0 miles (through downtown DeLand)

After crossing Spring Garden (Hwy 15a), you'll see a sign for Hontoon Island State Park & Amtrak

Turn left after the sign onto Old New York (fork to the left just before the train tracks)

Go about 1.8 miles (past Amtrak Station; past convenient store) and turn left onto Hontoon Rd. (you'll see the brown sign again for Hontoon Island)

Go 1.5 miles and turn left into the first driveway on the left after Hontoon Rd. makes a sharp left turn (but before Hontoon Rd. makes the sharp right turn!) and go straight onto the property.

#### FROM THE SOUTH (I-4)

Take the HWY 44 WEST exit #118 for DeLand/ New Smyrna Beach

Take this all the way into DeLand (about 5 minutes) After downtown continue a couple miles and cross Spring Garden (Hwy 15a)

After crossing Spring Garden (Hwy 15a), you'll see a sign for Hontoon Island State Park & Amtrak

Turn left after the sign onto Old New York (fork to the left just before the train tracks)

Go about 1.8 miles (past Amtrak Station; past convenient store) and turn left onto Hontoon Rd. (you'll see the brown sign again for Hontoon Island)
