## **REGATTA RULES**

- This is a USRA registered regatta. All races will be conducted following the USRA "Rules of Racing".
- The USRA Advertising rule is being waived.
- During a race, no boat shall have on board any electronic devices that are capable of sending or receiving information from any source external to the boat.
- Hot seating must be arranged with the dock master before the scheduled race.
- A crewmember must check-in with the dock master before launching for every race.
- All crews representing the same school/club must wear similar uniforms.
- Novice rowers are those who have started competing in regattas within a year of this regatta.
- You must have an entry in and "A" event before you can enter a "B" event.
- **One boat entry limit per school/club in all "A" events.**
- All other races have two-boat limit per school/club. (Third boat accepted if it does not cause extra heat.)
- **Rowers are limited to one sweep event.** (Special exceptions will be considered by LOC to fill no more than 1/4 of a boat.)
- All events shall have heats and finals, except Novice "B" events will be finals only.

#### **REGATTA INFORMATION**

- All races will be 2000 meters.
- **The lanes will be numbered from left to right. Lane six will be closest to the finish tower side of lake.**
- A starting dock with aligner will be used. **PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR COXSWAINS KNOW HOW TO BACK INTO A STARTING DOCK.**
- Bow markers for each race are required. **Supply your own bow marker.**
- Medals for first, second, and third place will be awarded.
- Trophies will be awarded for various events.

#### **LIGHTWEIGHTS**

- Lightweight weigh-in will be Friday between 6-8 P.M., and Saturday morning between 7-9 A.M. Entire crew must weigh-in together.
- Men's Lightweight is **155** - no average. • Women's Lightweight is **130** - no average

- Scratch deadline noon, **Tuesday, April 19** . Scratches after this date will forfeit their entry fee for that event
