Ottawa River

Welcome to the fourth annual Canadian Sculling Marathon (CSM), inspired by the worldrenowned Canadian Skiing Marathon. Stressing participation, endurance, fitness, distance, and fun, the CSM is the most complete sculling marathon in Canada. Offering a choice of three distances, the courses weave around three scenic islands in the Ottawa River, between Ottawa and Gatineau, and the full marathon may pass beneath the Parliament buildings. Organisers reserve the right to change the course due to adverse conditions.

Medals will be awarded to all scullers who complete any of the courses. T-shirts will be offered to all participants, while quantities last – t-shirts are guaranteed to participants registered by July 31. Participants should be in good physical condition and have rowed their target distance. Because of the nature of the course, all boats must carry Transport Canada mandated safety equipment: life jackets (one per individual), bailer, throw line and whistle.
