Lawrence Celebration Regatta Information

Welcome to the 3rd annual Lawrence Celebration Regatta. We are hosting a variety of categories over a four-lane, 1000-meter course on the beautiful Merrimack River. The launch site at the Greater Lawrence Community Boating has ample parking, overnight security for boat storage on Friday evening, and plenty of grassy park area for spectating and picnicking. Singles and doubles park and launch at the finish line area.

Directions:

From Rt. 93: Take Exit 45 (River Road/S. Lawrence) and head towards Lawrence. Go 1.7 miles until you see a sign for the "Lawrence Riverfront State Park." Take a left onto Eaton Street and follow signs to "The Boathouse."

Car top 1x and 2xs only proceed to finish line area: Follow directions above to Eaton St., and take a right onto Everett St. Follow the signs to the finish line site at the public boat ramp a few blocks down. There is ample parking and boat set-up space, as well as easy walking access to the main boathouse for facilities and announcements and coaches/coxswains meeting.

From South Broadway (Rt. 28) in Lawrence: Turn west onto Andover Street (Metropolitan Credit Union/Caesar's Pizza) and go 1/2-mile. Take right onto Eaton Street after you pass McDonald's. Follow signs to "The Boathouse."

Trailers: Follow directions above for parking at main boathouse lot.

Coaches/Coxswains meeting: 6:30 am, Saturday, June 11, 2005 in main lobby of the Bashara Boathouse. Please have a representative from your organization at the meeting and be on time. Course maps and traffic pattern will be given out at that time.

We will be following the USRowing rules of racing. USRA referees will officiate the regatta.

Racing: 1000 meters for all events.

Parking: Shell trailers only will be allowed to park in the lot at the boathouse. Follow directions above. Spectator and all other parking will be at the industrial park on Andover St., where spectators and competitors can catch a *free shuttle* back to the racecourse.
