Location: Acton Lake, Hueston Woods State Park, Oxford, OH.

Housing: Please contact (see below) the MURC if overnight housing is needed and arrangements will be made accordingly. Housing will not be automatically provided. Housing is also available for rigs who are arriving early if needed.

**Registration and Entry Information:** All entries will be made through Regatta Central. Please visit the website <u>www.regattacentral.com</u> and create an account to register your team if you have not already done so. The entry window opens Monday March 1, 2004 and ends Wednesday March 31, 2004. Please make all entries online. Events will include club, collegiate, and novice (High School invite only). A detailed schedule of the races will be added to our website soon, but is still in the process of being organized. The cost for entries are as follows: \$15 per single, \$20 per double, \$35 per 4+, \$45 per 8+. One waiver is needed for each participant and are available on regatta central's website.

**Check in:** Will begin April 3rd, 2004 at 7:00 am. Please check in at the registration stand upon arrival. Any scratches will result in a \$10 penalty the day of the race. **Waivers and payment should be brought to the race and delivered upon checking in.** 

**Coaches and coxswains:** Coach/Coxswain meeting will be held April 3rd<sup>h</sup>, 2004 at 7:30 am. Races will begin at 9:00 am. A heat sheet and updated race schedule will be provided at the meeting.

Lightweights: will be based on the honor system

**Course/Awards:** The course will be 2000 meters long and will begin with a floating start. Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> place teams and a plaque will be awarded to the team with the most overall points. This plaque will become an annual pass-down award and will need to be brought back the following year. If heats are needed for events, places will be determined based on time. These will be considered final results. **All teams will need to provide their own bow numbers**. Please contact us if this is a problem.

From I-75, take 275 W to the Colerain Ave. exit. Take a right off of the exit onto 27 N. Follow this road for about a half hour, until you reach the campus of Miami University. At the first stoplight at the entrance into Oxford, take a left onto Chestnut St. Follow this road until you come to a stop sign at the intersection of Chestnut St. and College Ave. Take a right and follow this road through town and out into the country (turns into Brown Rd.) When you come to a dead end, take a left. This road will take you on a winding path around the lake. When you come to the bottom of a large hill, take right and then immediate left into a parking lot filled with sailboats. Welcome to the Miami Boat House!
