### Welcome to the 2012 Royal Canadian Henley Masters Regatta

On behalf of the Henley Commission, we would like to thank you for participating in this year's Royal Canadian Henley Masters Regatta. This is the fourth year that the Henley Masters races have occupied their own day in the schedule. This year we have 267 entries and more than 380 competitors.

#### **Training and Racing Schedule**

The Henley course will be open for Masters training Saturday, August 4th from 2:00pm to 6:00pm, and Sunday, August 5th from 6:00am to 7:00am. Please have all boats off the course by 7:25am Sunday. We will conduct our coaches meeting at the Clerks Booth at 7:00am Sunday, August 5th. All competitors are welcome to attend. The Final Draw will be distributed during the coaches meeting. The first Heat will be called at 7:30am - please have proper photo identification accessible. Racing will start at 8:00am.

#### **Masters Office**

We will be setting up a dedicated Masters office, located in the south end of the regatta office/boat house. Access will be by the stairway between the two boathouses. Office hours for Masters' issues (name changes, scratches, and late entries) will be Saturday, August 4th from 12:00pm to 5:00pm and Sunday, August 5 from 8:00am to 9:00am. Please note: the deadline for late entries is 3:00pm Saturday.

Please pick up a copy of the course training map when you arrive on Henley Island. For the safety of all competitors, it is important to be aware of and observe all course traffic rules during training sessions and in the warm up period prior to racing.

#### **Changes to Henley Masters**

- For this year's racing we have scheduled an 18-minute break before the Mixed Finals to offer competitors additional time to prepare.
- We will be returning to the traditional Non-Static umpire boats for following the races.
- The water truck will be back and located near the gas shed.
- Live results will be available if you point your browser on your laptop or handheld to reports.regattamaster.com - click on the link Henley Masters, then click Races at the top of the page, click on the tiny arrow on the left of the event to display details. Please visit the Internet Café for your results, located across from the Henley Island Helpers Concession stand.

#### **Access to Henley Island and Grandstand**

There will be no wristbands issued to Masters competitors. No admission will be charged for access to Henley Grandstand Sunday, August 5th or to Henley Island from Saturday, August 4th to Tuesday, August 7th. Normal admission charges will apply to both locations from Wednesday, August 8th to Sunday, August 12th.

Masters Coxie Weigh-Ins - There will be no weighing in of Masters coxies.

#### **Masters and Volunteer Barbeque**

We would like to invite all Masters Competitors, Coaches, and Regatta Volunteers to join us for a celebratory barbeque at the conclusion of racing on Sunday, August 5th from 3:00pm to 6:00pm. We will provide a burger or hotdog and a free drink to each participant, and additional beverages will be available for purchase. The barbecue will be held at the St. Catharines Rowing Alumni Club House, situated a short walk from the boathouse at the top of Henley Island where there is a commanding view of Martindale Pond.



**Circulation Du Trafic Pendant Les Courses Masters** 




