

# Stonewall Regatta Parking Instructions and Race-Day Logistics

Anacostia Community Boathouse 1900 M St. S.E., Washington DC

Sunday, June 1, 2014

## **Spectator and Participant Parking**

- There will be NO parking at, or proximate to, the ACBA boathouse, with the exception of boat trailers and car-topped sculls.
- All other vehicles MUST park in the upper lot at Maritime Plaza (1201 M St. SE, entrance from the M Street traffic circle).
- The regatta parking area will be marked; vehicles parked elsewhere risk being towed.
- Parking monitors will be located at the circle and in the lot to assist with parking and to direct pedestrians to boathouse shuttles.
- Portions of M St SE are closed due to ongoing construction, so O St/Water St SE is being used as a detour.
- The detour route to the boathouse is 1.3 miles long by car (1.0 mile walk), so shuttle service will be provided between the Maritime Plaza lot and the boathouse (see attached map).
- Rowers and gear may be dropped off at the Pennsylvania Avenue Bridge Overpass, but vehicles will NOT be allowed to proceed to the boathouse. Individuals with disabilities may be dropped off directly in front of the boathouse but may not park in the handicapped spaces; this area must be kept clear to facilitate the drop off of adaptive rowers and people taking the parking shuttles from Maritime Plaza.

# **Trailer Parking**

- The ACBA lot will open for boat trailer parking starting at 6am.
- Parking monitors will be on-site to direct trailer parking.

# Rower Drop-off/Pick-up

- Rowers may be dropped-off at the turnabout under the Pennsylvania Avenue overpass (M street passes under this); vehicles will not be allowed to proceed beyond this point.
- To avoid congestion, and allow trailers clear access to depart the boathouse, rowers being picked up by others at the end of the day should plan to do so from the Maritime Plaza parking lot

- Parking shuttles will run all day between the Maritime lot and the boathouse. The shuttles will run from 6am to 4:30. They will run constantly first thing in the morning and towards the end of the day; from about 9am until 2:30 they will run about every 20 minutes.

## **Parking for Individuals with Disabilities**

Unfortunately there are not enough parking spaces at the ACBA boathouse for all
participants requiring such accommodation. We are reserving this parking area for
the drop off and pick-up of participants with disabilities, but long-term parking will
not be permitted.

#### **Team Tents**

- Teams may set up tents inside the ACBA parking lot, along the riverbank (see attached map).
- Tents may not block the dock access ramps, or inhibit access to the parking lot.

#### **Bathrooms**

- Semi-permanent bathroom trailers, including shower and changing facilities, will be available.
- Portable chemical toilets will also be available for overflow use.

### **Spectators**

- Spectators are welcome!
- Prime viewing locations include the Anacostia Riverwalk pedestrian overpass and Anacostia Park, on the opposite shore line (see attached map).
- Course viewing from inside the boathouse compound is limited.

#### From Maryland to the Anacostia Community Boathouse:

From I-295 South, take the exit onto the 11<sup>th</sup> St Bridge, 695N. Exit toward M St/Washington Navy Yard.

- For Maritime Plaza Parking: Turn right onto M St and continue to the traffic circle and Maritime Plaza.
- For trailers, car-topped sculls, and dropping off people, turn left on M and an immediate left onto 11<sup>th</sup>, but stay to the right. Go through the flashing yellow light and make a left at the next light onto O/Water St. Go straight and it will re-join M Street to the boathouse. After dropping off, to get back to Maritime, go back on M St and the O/Water St detour, make a right at the stop sign onto 12<sup>th</sup>, and a right onto M and go to the traffic circle.

#### From Virginia to the Anacostia Community Boathouse:

From I-395 North, continue onto the Southwest Freeway. Once you are out of the Confederacy and in the District (after the bridge), stay towards the left. At this point do NOT follow 395 anymore; go past that exit and take the 6<sup>th</sup> St SE exit toward Navy Yard. Continue Straight onto Virginia Avenue. Turn right onto 8<sup>th</sup> St SE. Turn left onto M St SE.

- For Maritime Plaza Parking: Proceed down M St under the overpass until you get to the traffic circle, where you will find Maritime Plaza and smiley volunteers to direct you.

Turn right onto 11<sup>th</sup> St SE; at the second traffic light before the bridge make a left onto O St SE/Water St SE. Continue until it merges with M St SE past the road construction.


-For trailers, car-topped sculls, and dropping off, from M St make a right onto 11<sup>th</sup> St SE (right before the overpasses) but stay to the right. Go through the flashing yellow light and make a left at the next light onto O/Water St. Go straight and it will re-join M Street to the boathouse. After dropping off, to get back to Maritime, follow M and detour onto O/Water, turn right at the stop sign onto 12<sup>th</sup>, and then right on M and to the traffic circle.

Boathouse Address (for drop offs): 1900 M St, SE, Washington, DC

Parking Address (Maritime Plaza): 1201 M St, SE, Washington, DC PLEASE NOTE THAT M STREET PAST THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE IS CURRENTLY CLOSED DUE TO ONGOING CONSTRUCTION! WATER ST SE SERVES AS THE DETOUR ROUTE, AND WILL MERGE INTO M ST, PAST THE ROAD CLOSURE. DRIVERS SHOULD PROCEED WITH CAUTION.
