Regatta Site: Delta Deas Regional Park

Entries Due: All entries must be completed and submitted by midnight Tuesday, May 17, 2016.

Late entries will be accepted only if they do not create new heats.

Regatta Entries: Located on Regatta Central.

There will be an entry cap of four entries per event per club. Additional entries will be put on a wait list. If event cap has not been reached, wait list entries will be added in the order received

until event cap is reached. This particularly applies to Jr A and B, 1X and 2X events.

Eligibility: All athletes must be currently registered with their provincial association and RCA.

American entries must be registered with USRA.

Classifications:

Junior A: All competitors, including coxswains, must have their18th birthday on or after January 1st, 2016.

Junior B: All competitors, including coxswains, must have their 16th birthday on or after January 1st, 2016.

Junior C: All competitors, including coxswains, must have their 14th birthday on or after January 1st, 2016.

Lightweight: Each crewmember must be no more than 72 kg for men and 61.5 kg for women. No averaging.

Novice: New to sport on or after August 1st, 2015.

Coxswains: Minimum weight for all coxswains is 45 kg. (Honor system)

Weigh-ins: Weigh-in for each lightweight rower will be from 6:45 to 10 am the morning of the rower's lightweight

event (Saturday for women and Sunday for men). Weigh-in for coxswains will be on the honor system.

Progression: Junior A 2X and 1x events; Junior B 2X and 1X events and Junior Lightweight 1X event with more than 7

entries will use a Time Trial to seed an A final. If these events have over 13 entries, there will also be a B Final. All other A and B events with more than 18 entries will constitute a Time Trial to be run on Saturday

or Sunday morning to form a one 6 boat final. Heats will be run for entries between 8-18.

Junior C Mens and Womens C 1X events, no final, best times from heats - therefore there will not be a

conflict with the Jr B Mens and Womens 1X events

Please note: An athlete cannot compete in both Jr A 1X and Jr A Itwt 1X. Time trial time for these

two events will go towards only one event final.

Bow Markers: Will be provided by the Regatta. ALL shells must be fitted with bow clips.

Rules of racing: Rowing Canada rules of racing will apply.

Security: Security will be provided at the regatta site Friday, Saturday and Sunday night.
