

Dillon Lake Scholastic Sprints

Date: 4/18/2015

Location: Dillon Lake State Park, Nashport, OH

Check-in: All teams should check in at the registration tent located at the end of the parking lot near the horseshoe of the road.

Weigh-ins: Weigh-in will be from 6:30am to 9:30am Saturday, April 18th, 2014 in the picnic shelter located by the playground. Lightweight girls are 130lbs. and lightweight boys are 150lbs. NO EXCEPTIONS. Rowers must weigh in as a team from bow to stern in their uniforms. Rowers must keep their wrist band throughout the regatta.

Coaches and Coxswains Meeting: C&C meeting will be held at 7:00am under the pavilion located at the top near the playground and tennis courts.

LANE SELECTION: Lane selection will be done using Regatta Workbench regatta software. This regatta management software collects the data from Regatta Central and automatically seeds crews randomly. All teams are responsible for their own bow markers.

LAUNCHING: There will be two calls to launch prior to each event as scheduled. Launch officials at the launch docks will make every effort to launch boats on time. It is your responsibility to report to the starting line on time, regardless if you hear the race calls or not. A representative must check-in with the dock master before launching for every race. Coaches and coxswains should be ready to launch 45 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event.

PRACTICE: Marshalled practice will be available 3-7pm Friday

BUSES:

- Have buses move to the designated loading/unloading area upon arrival as shown on the Regatta Map.
- Place Emergency card (attached below) on the left side windshield of the bus. This will help us in case of an emergency situation.
- Obey the 5 mph speed limit in the areas of loading/unloading boats, chuck wagons and buses.
- No buses are to park in the Camp Store Parking Lot

Tents and Chuckwagons:

- Set up your tent site anywhere within the designated tent area. Please be mindful of your neighbors.
- Staking of tents is permitted.
- Park in the designated parking area provided for your Chuckwagon and vehicle.
- Keep your tent area clean. Any team neglecting to maintain their site(s) will be assessed a \$75.00 charge.
- Be aware that tent and food equipment will need to be carried to your site.

- Chuckwagon trailers are not permitted on the grass or lanes down to the beach area.
- Obey the 5 mph speed limit in the areas of loading/unloading boats, chuck wagons and buses.

Shells:

- Store boats in designated shell areas only. Please be mindful of your neighbors.
- Keep your boat area clean. Any team neglecting to maintain their site(s) will be assessed a \$75.00 charge.
- Unload boat trailers within the 30 minute time limit.
- Trailers are not permitted on the lawns or beaches.
- Once your equipment is unloaded, please move your trailers and tow units to the areas marked.

Weather: Delays should there be delays because of inclement weather the following sequence of schedule adjustments would be followed:

Contingency A - Weather (late start, i.e. fog)

- Run all Novice events as flights, cut all breaks. (time saved: approx. 1.5 hours)

Contingency B – Weather (Wind/waves)

- Cancel in order from most affected shells starting with:
 - 1x – (Events 3 & 4)
 - 2x – (Events 1 & 2)
 - N 4+ (Events 15 & 16)
 - All 4+ (Events 7,8,9,10,15,16,17,18)
 - N 8+ and F 8+
 - Only Varsity 8+'s (includes Ltwt 8+) row
 - Cancel ALL events

Contingency C – Sudden weather causing all shells to be removed from the water

- Medal each heat as flights

Contingency D – (Darkness/Delayed)

- Priority Order:
 - 8+'s in descending order (V, Ltwt, 2nd, JR, F, N)
 - 2x
 - 1x
 - 4+'s in descending order (V, Ltwt, JR, N)
