### **Regatta Format:**

#### **EIGHTS**

- All eights will row a 1500 meter TT (time trial) for placement in the finals and lanes.
- 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> TT 1V Eights will row in the 1V Final. 7<sup>th</sup> place and on will move to 2V final.
- Novice Eights will row in the 1N and 2N Finals.
- All other eights will be assigned to the 2V and 3V8 Finals according to their TT finish.
- The time Trial will be head race style using the last 1500 meters on the race course.
- TT starting order will be based on "guest crews" followed by last years finishing order.
- Times from the time trial will not be posted until after the event.
- Places as well as event and lane assignments will be posted at the Officials Table.

#### **FOURS:**

- Race and Lane assignments for the Fours finals will be based on the eights am Time Trial.
- All crews not rowing eights will be seeded in available lanes and levels.
- Lightweight Fours will automatically receive a lane assignment in the 2V/Lwt. Four event.

**Frosh/Novice** must be an academic freshman or in the first full academic year of rowing.

**3rd Varsity Four-** cannot include anyone in the 1<sup>st</sup> Varsity eight unless they are bona fide Lightweight rowers.

**4<sup>th</sup> Varsity Four-** – This event is meant for the spares and those who do not have a race. In fairness we ask coaches to row their spares and use no 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> level athletes unless they are needed to provide those athletes a chance to race.
