- All regatta participating organizations must be an active member of US Rowing and compete under their
 official US Rowing membership name. The only exceptions are Unaffiliated Single Scullers. These single
 scullers must be Individual Members of US Rowing and must race as Unaffiliated.
- All athletes must submit a US Rowing Waiver. Please see Waiver-Registration Instructions included in this packet.

All crews park their trailers and cars at the Canoe Club. The Canoe Club is between St. Joe's Boathouse and the Strawberry Mansion Bridge on Kelly Drive. **Trailers park on the up riverside of the Canoe Club. Hutchinson Cup trailer parking signs will mark the area.**

Out of Town Crews Launching:

Out of town crews launch from the Canoe Club dock. Launch from the dock marked LAUNCH dock and return to the dock marked RECOVERY dock.

Traffic Pattern-Safety Instructions-Penalties In the interest of safety and fairness we ask you to make note of the following:

1. Racing lanes take you through the <u>second or third</u> arches of bridges. At the Start <u>look for</u> <u>lane number 3 on the Strawberry Mansion Bridge</u>. <u>Use the orange buoys as a guide</u>. Do not race downstream through other arches; this is a traffic pattern violation and you will hit upstream traffic.

2. On those portions of the course that are straight, a crew being overtaken shall move to the right and allow the overtaking crew to pass. Where the course turns, the crew being overtaken shall move to the outside of the turn and allow the overtaking crew to pass along the shorter path.

A crew is deemed to be overtaking another crew, if it moves to within one boat length of the crew ahead. The crew being overtaken must yield, if they can safely do so.

3. Do not pass at bridges or if otherwise unsafe to do so – this is a safety violation subject to penalty.

4. Follow the published traffic pattern and do not cross the racecourse unless directed by a marshal or referee.

5. Penalty for:

- Late to the Start Line All boats are responsible for being in the marshal area, ready to row, at least 5 minutes prior to the scheduled event time. Once an event has started no boats from previous events will be permitted to start and they will not be timed down the course. Late crews will have to wait at the top of the river until they are directed by a race official to proceed safely down the course to return to their launching dock.
- Failure to Yield 60 second penalty or possible exclusion for extended or repeated violations.
- Interference, Violation of the Traffic Pattern, or Safety Violation May include; reprimand, warning, exclusion or disqualification.

Referees will be alert for traffic pattern violations, interference with other crews and crews late to the Start Line. Race hard and have a safe regatta. Thank you, Regatta Officials

- I. All athletes must have a US Rowing Waiver on file with our regatta.
- II. If you are a <u>new user</u> to Regatta Central, please follow these steps to register:

 - 4. If your Roster Code appears, please copy and paste the entire instructions page into an email for other athletes (or parents of athletes) listed in your Roster
 - 5. If your Roster Code does not appear, contact US Rowing to determine the status of your club
 - 6. To submit you own waiver, click the www.regattacentral.com/athletes link
 - 7. Enter your Roster Code and last name and click 'Begin'
 - 8. Click on your name link
 - 9. If you (or your child) are a paid US Rowing member, select the 'Yes' option and enter the US Rowing membership #
 - 10. If you (or your child) are not a paid individual member of US Rowing, select the 'No' option and continue

Masters Turning Stake Races

Men's and Women's 1X Men's and Women's 2X Mixed 2X

In the classic style of the Biglin Brothers and rowers of old, the Turning the Stake Races require all competitors to turn around two buoyed stakes.

The race will begin at the Starting line, the Viking statue, traveling up river (West River Drive side, opposite Boathouse Row). The Turning Stakes will be positioned before the Girard Avenue bridge (first bridge going up river). <u>Competitors will do a U Turn around two Stakes</u>. Once the competitors' boat and oars have gone <u>completely around both stakes</u>, each boat will follow a down river course (Kelly Drive/Boathouse Row side) to the Finish line (which is the same as the Starting line) at the Viking statue.

Each boat is timed. Timing begins when each boat crosses the Start line and will stop when each boat has crossed the Finish line. The course is approximately 500m up and 500m back for a round trip total of approximately 1000m. Boats will be sent off in a time trial/head race fashion with approximately 10 second breaks between boats.

Hutchinson Cup Directions for Out of Town Crews

From New York/New England:

- From southbound New Jersey Turnpike (NJTP), take exit 6 to Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276 West).
- Follow PA Turnpike to exit 25A (Mid County).
- Take this exit (keeping to the left) and follow signs to I-476 South (Chester).
- After toll booth, take I-476 South to exit 6 (junction with I-76 East, the Schuylkill Expressway) Philadelphia/Valley Forge.
- Take this exit (on right), stay in left lane of exit and follow signs for Philadelphia.
- Follow I-76 East to exit 340 on the left.
- Take this exit and stay in the left lane as you go over City Avenue Bridge across the Schuylkill River.
- Stay left and follow signs for Kelly Drive.
- The ramp will spiral downwards in a counter-clockwise direction and will merge you onto Kelly Drive, southbound. Be very careful, especially if you are pulling a boat trailer on this tight, descending curve!
- Move to right lane of Kelly Drive after merging at the bottom of the spiral.
- Take Kelly Drive past four traffic lights.
- The first building on the right, between the river and Kelly Drive, is the Canoe Club, where all out-of-town crews launch.
- Take a right into the parking lot.
- Continue two miles on Kelly Drive to Boathouse Row and Regatta Headquarters at #10, Vesper Boat Club.

From Scranton/Allentown:

- Take Northeast Extension of PA Turnpike (Route 9 South) south to exit 25 (Mid-County).
- Take this exit (keeping to the left) and follow signs to I-476 South (Chester).
- After toll booth, take I-476 South to exit 6 (junction with I-76 East, the Schuylkill Expressway) Philadelphia/Valley Forge.
- Take this exit (on right), stay in left lane of exit and follow signs for Philadelphia.
- Follow I-76 East to exit 340 on the left.
- Take this exit and get in the left lane as you go over City Avenue Bridge across the Schuylkill River.
- Stay left and follow signs for Kelly Drive.
- The ramp will spiral downwards in a counter-clockwise direction and will merge you onto Kelly Drive, southbound. Be very careful, especially if you are pulling a boat trailer on this tight, descending curve!

From Harrisburg:

- Take PA Turnpike East to Exit 34.
- Follow I-76 East (Schuylkill Expressway) towards Philadelphia.
- Follow I-76 East to exit 340 on the right.
- Take this exit and stay in the left lane as you go over City Avenue Bridge across the Schuylkill River.
- Stay left and follow signs for Kelly Drive.
- The ramp will spiral downwards in a counter-clockwise direction and will merge you onto Kelly Drive, southbound. Be very careful, especially if you are pulling a boat trailer on this tight, descending curve!
- Move to right lane of Kelly Drive after merging at the bottom of the spiral.
- Take Kelly Drive past four traffic lights. (continued next page)
- The first building on the right, between the river and Kelly Drive, is the Canoe Club, where all out-of-town crews launch. (continued next page)

- Take a right into the parking lot.
- Regatta Headquarters is located two miles downriver on Kelly Dr., Vesper Boat Club, # 10 Boathouse Row.

From Washington, DC, Baltimore, Wilmington:

- Take I-95 North through Wilmington to Philadelphia International Airport and follow signs for Phila Center City via Route I-76 or Schuylkill Expressway
- Take exit, I-76, Schuylkill Expressway, west. This takes you across the Penrose Ave. Bridge across Schuylkill, a.k.a. Route 291.
- As soon as you come down bridge get in left lane, as you will turn left at first light onto 26th Street.
- This will take you directly onto I-76 west. Follow I-76 about 8 miles, past Boathouse Row and the race course.
- Follow I-76 West to exit 340 on the right.
- Take this exit, turn right at foot of exit and get in the left lane as you go over City Avenue Bridge across the Schuylkill River.
- Stay left and follow signs for Kelly Drive.
- The ramp will spiral downwards in a counter-clockwise direction and will merge you onto Kelly Drive, southbound. Be very careful, especially if you are pulling a boat trailer on this tight, descending curve!
- Move to right lane of Kelly Drive after merging at the bottom of the spiral.
- Take Kelly Drive past four traffic lights.
- The first building on the right, between the river and Kelly Drive, is the Canoe Club, where all out-of-town crews launch.

- Take I-76, the Schuylkill Expressway, west.
- Follow I-76 West to exit 340 on the right.

- Stay left and follow signs for Kelly Drive.
- The ramp will spiral downwards in a counter-clockwise direction and will merge you onto Kelly Drive, southbound. Be very careful, especially if you are pulling a boat trailer on this tight, descending curve!
- Move to right lane of Kelly Drive after merging at the bottom of the spiral.
- Take Kelly Drive past four traffic lights.
