  - Online info will be available at the registration desk


### SAFETY PLAN

- Registration tent has basic first-aid supplies
  - Directions to rapid care at registration tent
- Call 911 Immediately if needed

- Severe weather:
  - At Rock River Landing Park the bathroom building is the shelter
  - On-water crews to be brought to shore immediately

### STARTING FROM ARRIVAL

- The park will open at noon on Saturday
- The course will be open for practice from 2pm to 5pm
- Sunday arrivals at 5am
- Local police will be perforing increase monitoring of the site at night
- Trailers must be parked with 6 feet between. I3 trailers in the paved lot.




## SITE LAYOUT

- Team Tents Along River- Not assigned, be courteous
- 3 Docks
  - 2 large docks are single sided
  - Small dock for IX, 2X and 2- only.
    Able to launch and recover on both sides
  - Step down from main floating dock
  - River level is low, so ramps are at an angle- Slow and steady.
- Please setup as far to North side as possible




## **BUSES**

# PUERNER STREET BRIDGE SPECTATOR VIEWING




#### Traffic:

## SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS

# WISCO CHASE COURSE OVERVIEW

- 3,000 meters total length
- Start and Finish lines are timed from shore tents
- "Powerline Stretch" in middle provides great 850m straight line opportunity for moves
- Racecourse is in protected water. There have never been whitecaps on the course!





## **COURSE DETAIL**

- Course moved upstream (North) about 200m to allow officials to be based on shore
- Course length at buoy line 3,200m

- No passing near bridge- Penalty will be issued
- KEEP CENTER BUIYS ON STARBOARD SIDE
