# You're Invited!

The Kenora Rowing Club invites you to join us for the 2023 Tops and Bottoms regatta on Rabbit Lake in Kenora — our first comeback since 2019! Tops & Bottoms will feature both a 1000m Masters and a 2000m Junior course plus a 400m Mixed Mash Dash! The Kenora Rowing Club regatta venue is situated on Rabbit Lake, with Garrow Park and a public beach right next door, just 10 minutes from downtown Kenora. Tops and Bottoms is an ideal development regatta earlier in the season for novice rowers. The focus of the event is for Masters (tops) and Juniors (bottoms) to gain experience racing, get to know fellow regional rowing clubs, and work towards their race and/or time goals.

# **Regatta Site**

The Kenora Rowing Club has worked hard to produce an exceptional venue for rowing regattas, including a buoyed course with stake-boat holders. The venue saw high quality facility upgrades in 2017 after hosting the Canada Summer Games. The Kenora Rowing Club is located at 110 Birchwood Crescent on the south side of Rabbit Lake. There is room for boat storage on site, and the location is equipped with washrooms, First Aid, and a concession stand.

# **Accommodations**

Kenora sees a huge influx of tourists and seasonal residents in the summer, so book your accommodations as soon as possible! There are several hotels, resorts and camp grounds in the area. # **Awards and Entertainment**

Awards will be given to the top finishers of each event at end of the day. A BBQ will be held on site directly following the regatta and awards ceremony. Tickets for non-rowers will be available on-site throughout the regatta.

# **Eligibility/Categories**

Novice Defined as any rower in their first year of rowing. Coaches can state which

crew are novices when reviewing race schedule at the coaches' meeting on

Friday night.

Junior B/U17 An individual who will be 16 or under on December 31, 2023.

Junior U19 An individual who in the current calendar year does not attain the age of 19, or

who is and has been continuously enrolled in secondary school as a full-time

student seeking a diploma.

Master Rowers An individual who has attained or will attain the age of 21 or older on

December 31, 2023. An individual age is determined as of December 31, 2023.

Crew's average age is rounded down to the nearest whole number.

Masters will be age adjusted based on Rowing Canada Aviron Garrett Masters'

Age Adjusted Time System (2021 Edition).

Rowers that are neither Junior nor Master can row as exhibition in the Junior events.
