Chicago Sprints Regatta

Since its inception in 1980, The Chicago Sprints Regatta has been a large and highly visible event and provides a unique opportunity to showcase the Lincoln Park Boat Club and its sponsors to the Midwest rowing community. The Chicago Sprints is the largest sprint-season regatta in the Midwest, and among the top 5 largest non-collegiate sprint regattas in the nation. Highly competitive, it draws on the wealth of talent at the Lincoln Park Boat Club, rowing clubs throughout the region, the Midwest National Development team, and nationally ranked junior and collegiate programs. In 2010 the Lincoln Park Boad Club's Chicago Sprints Regatta was host to 670 athletes, fielding 294 entries from 29 clubs througout 8 states. In addition, it was attended by over 1000 casual and dedicated spectators who lines the thousand meter course situated between Lake Shore Drive and the Lincoln Park Zoo.

In 2011, the Chicago Sprints Regatta will be one of only three 'open' regattas in the Midwest. By assisting us in hosting this regatta, you will allow the Lincoln Park Boat Club to provide a valuable service to the rowing community and fill a demonstrated need by offering a venue for rowing competitions.
