### VENDOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Exhibitor agrees to have his/her booth open and staffed during the show hours.

Exhibitor agrees to conform to all Seattle Fire Department Rules and Regulations and those of the venue.

Exhibitor agrees that all booth materials, literature/products, etc. shall be removed from the venue by 5:30pm, Saturday, February 6, 2016.

Exhibitor agrees to accept the space assigned to by the Event Coordinator.

Exhibitor agrees that no exhibitor shall have the authority to incur costs or liability against the George Pocock Rowing Foundation or the venue. Exhibitor shall be liable for all damages which he/she may cause to the building or otherwise in connection to his/her exhibit.

Exhibitor agrees to carry the necessary workman's comprehensive general liability insurance and any other insurance required by the State of Washington. A certificate of insurance may be required to be shown.

Exhibitor agrees to assume all responsibility for loss, theft, or destructions of goods or for personal injuries to himself/herself, his/her employees, representatives, or visitors, and will hold harmless the George Pocock Rowing Foundation from any and all liability in connection with any and all of the above.

Exhibitor understands that neither the George Pocock Rowing Foundation nor the City of Seattle Parks and Recreation Department maintains insurance covering the exhibitor's property or lost revenue and it is sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain such insurance.

FOOD VENDORS: Food Vendors of any kind must have a King County Food Handlers Permit from the Health Department and it must be on display at your booth. (Allow three weeks for processing this permit. Contact the Food Handlers Permit Hotline at (206) 296-4791 or visit www.metrokc.gov). Food vendors must also have a temporary food service permit from King County. (Allow at least 14 days for processing. For more information call (206) 205-1924 or visit <a href="www.metrokc.gov">www.metrokc.gov</a>).

All vendors are required to carry commercial general liability insurance at limits of no less than \$1 million per occurrence and \$2 million aggregate. In addition, The George Pocock Rowing Foundation and the City of Seattle Parks & Recreation must be named as additional insured. *Certificate of insurance is due two weeks prior to the event*.

I agree to indemnify and HOLD HARMLESS the George Pocock Rowing Foundation and the City of Seattle, employees, officers, volunteers, sponsors and agents from any and all claims arising by reason of accident, injury or death caused by persons or property of any kind arising out of, in connection with, or incident to the NWErgomania.

I understand that any violation of the above regulations will result in eviction from this event and forfeiture of my entry fee.
