Trailing

For those clubs coming with a trailer, trailers can arrive on site as early as 12:00pm on Friday. There will be overnight security both Friday and Saturday evening.

The south/east lot is reserved for large trailers. Upon arrival start at the most southern spot and work north.

The North/east lot is reserved for smaller trailers. Please start at the west point and work east.

The remaining 10 spots will be overflow for either size trailer. Please fill lots east to west.



Practice Times

Practice times for Saturday and Sunday morning have been adjusted to ensure there is time to get safety boats on the water in time for the first event. Practice times for the weekend are:

Friday 15:00 to 18:45
Saturday 06:30 to 07:15 & 20 minutes after the last race to 18:30
Sunday 06:30 to 07:15

Practices will only be permitted if clubs provide safety boat drivers.

The number of crews and the distance practice will be permitted will depend on the number of safety boat drivers that sign up.

Safety boat drivers **MUST** sign in at the regatta office before going on the water. They will be assigned a position on the water and will not be permitted to follow their crews and coach. **When signing in, safety boat drivers must present their PCOC.** Each safety boat driver will be assigned a radio for communication while in the boat. Safety boat drivers can sign up starting at 14:30 when the regatta office opens. Safety boat driver must come back to the regatta office to return the radio and sign out once they have completed their shift.

Crews **MUST** sign up for a practice time slot at the regatta office, so the number of crews on the water can be managed and tracked. Crews will have to indicate when they plan to launch and when they plan to return when signing in. All crews must check in with the dock marshal once they have return so we can account for all crews. Any crews practicing without checking in/out or without safety boats present will be issued a Yellow Card when they check into Control Commission for their first event.

Crews will not be permitted to go past the start for practice.

Parking

Parking at the boathouse is reserved for regatta personal and officials only. There is parking off Colborne St., near the train bridge for athletes, coaches etc. There will be 6 person golf cart shuttles available both days to shuttle people to and from the boathouse and parking lot. There will not be a shuttle to and from the finish tower, however there is limited parking at the finish tower.

Tow vehicles will be permitted to park with the trailer and/or along the northside of the trailer lot.

If space permits those that are car topping may also park in the north end of the trailer compound.

Coaches and Team/Club Representatives Meeting

A reminder that the coaches meeting is at 19:15 at the Pavilion near the boathouse. All clubs are required to have a minimum one representative at the meeting as per the 2022 RCA Rules of Racing 8.6. Roll call will be taken at the beginning of the meeting.

Calling Crews

Races will NOT be called. Crews will be responsible for managing their own time.

Weigh-ins

The official weigh-in scales and practice scale will be in the Quonset Hut next to the compound parking lot. All coxswains and weight restricted athletes will be required to present photo ID when weighing in.

Weigh-in times for both Saturday and Sunday will be

- Open at 07:15 (75 minutes before first race)
- Close at 09:45 (2.5 hours after opening)

Proof of Age and Identity at Control Commission:

All competitors (including coxswains) will be required to show photo ID at Control Commission for every race. Please review the ID requirements and options listed in the Regatta Information Package. There will be no exceptions to the ID requirements.

Vendors

While things can change, there is scheduled to be a food vendor at the finish tower and boathouse both days. In addition, Row Ontario's apparel partner, Regatta Sport will be on site selling merch both days as well.
