# Bulletin No. 1

May 2, 2016

Rowing British Columbia is looking forward to hosting the annual RCA National Rowing Championships and the RCA Canada Cup regatta (NRC-CC) from Thursday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup> 2016. The venue for this new, combined event is Burnaby Lake, Burnaby, B.C. Site of the 1973 Canada Games regatta, Burnaby Lake is known for its calm water, little, if any wind and fair racing across all six of its 2000 m buoyed lanes. Jessica Lowe, co-chair of the very successful 2014 RCA Canadian Masters Championships, held at the lake, is the Chair of the 2016 NRC-CC Organizing Committee and former FISA umpire Mike Bagshawe will be the Chief Umpire for the regatta.

2016 represents the return of the Canada Cup concept and will include provincial and regional teams racing in 2x, 4-, 4x and 8+ events. And within the Canada Cup are two events to help provincial rowing associations identify and select athletes for the Canada Games. Please see the attached NRC-CC Technical Package for the full list of events.

An athlete awards banquet will be held after the conclusion of the NRC on the Saturday evening that will include the NRC medal presentation ceremonies and a dinner. Tickets will be automatically included in the regatta entry fees. The Canada Cup regatta will be run on the Sunday.

#### **RIGHT OF ENTRY:**

The NRC-CC is designed to allow national team athletes to "re-connect" with their home club and provincial rowing association. Athletes based at the national training centres shall register with a club (and the club will register them with the PRA and RCA) in the province they decide to compete in the NRC-CC.

For 2016 NRC-CC the provincial rowing association coaches determine the entries for all the athletes representing their PRA, including the above referenced national training centre athletes. Only the PRA's make entries to the National Rowing Championships and to the Canada Cup.

To be eligible to compete in the Canada Cup events, athletes must be entered in the National Rowing Championships. PRA's, however, are not required to enter their 2017 Canada Games eligible athletes in NRC events in order to be eligible to compete in the W4x and M4x Canada Games races. We do however, strongly encourage all Canada Games athletes to race in the NRCs as well as their Canada Games events on Sunday.

Please note the Canada Games events age limit changes each year in relation to the year of the Games as follows:

2016 Under 20

2017 Under 17 (Canada Games August)

2018 Under 18

2019 Under 19

2020 Under 20

2021 Under 17 (Canada Games August)

#### **EVENTS:**

Please see TP sections 6.3 for a list of the 24 NRC events and § 6.4 for the ten Canada Cup events. The NRC events will be run Thursday through Saturday. It is anticipated Canada Cup racing should be concluded by 11:30am on Sunday.

#### **WEIGH-INS:**

FISA rules will be applied for all weigh-ins. To accommodate lightweight rowers in the NRC events forming crew boats in the CC events, the FISA crew average weight limit will not be applied in the CC events. Instead, each crew member will be allowed to weigh the FISA maximum weight i.e., LW 59 kg; LM 72.5 kg. Please see TP sections 7. 1 and 7.2 for additional information.

### **PROGRESSION SYSTEM:**

All NRC events will commence with 1900 m time trials in their respective groups, instead of heats, regardless of the number of total entries within a group. Over the Thursday, and Friday there will also be repêchages, quarterfinals and semifinals as required by the number of entries. Finals C and D and lower will be held on Friday. Saturday finals B and A and the PARA events will be held.

Crews in the Sunday Canada Cup events compete over 2000 m and then over 500 m. Winners will be determined by combining the 2000 m and 500 m times divided by 5 to get the average 500 m time for both events. The lowest average time wins.

## **EQUIPMENT:**

Each province is responsible for the provision of all boats, oars and sculls as required for each race. Boat racks will be available at Burnaby Lake.

## RCA PROVINCIAL PARTICIPATION SUPPORT FUNDING PROGRAMME:

The PPSFP programme will be in place for the 2016 NRC-CC and the pool of funds is the same as 2015, \$30,000. Detailed information on the programme will be forwarded from the RCA office in the near future.

## **ENTRY FEE:**

Fees found in the table below are per competitor. Fees allow entry into 1 NRC event, and all CC events as permitted by the schedule. All fees include a ticket to the Athlete Awards Banquet on Saturday evening. Competitors who do not attend the banquet will not be reimbursed. Additional tickets for the banquet can be purchased online at a later date. A 5% GST will be added to the cost of all fees.

#### **ENTRY PROCESS AND ENTRY DEADLINE:**

Entries will only be accepted from individuals that have already been designated by the provincial rowing associations. Athletes must be registered with their club, province and RCA through the WRS prior to any entry being made. An alpha competitor list will be required from each province.

RegattaCentral online registration will open Monday, June 13, 2016.

The deadline to submit entries and entry fees is 11:59pm PDT, Monday, September 12, 2016. Club coaches should contact their PRA for internal selection deadlines.

Entries for which payment has not been submitted by the entry deadline <u>will not be</u> drawn.

Late entries will not be accepted for the 2016 NRC-CC.

A fee of \$50.00 will be levied for each scratch and 'no show'. The name change fee will be \$10.00 per competitor. Name changes will not be allowed if competitors are not on the alpha competitor list.

A preliminary draw will be posted Friday, September 16, 2016.
