

ACCREDITATION

Please note that accreditation for all coaches, athletes and team officials can only be collected by **one (1)** representative of each Team competing at the SIRR. Accreditations can be collected starting on Thursday 14th March at the Accreditation Centre which will be located just inside Gate A at SIRC.

The Accreditation Centre will be open at the following times:

Friday 15 th March	9:00am – 11:00am and 3:00pm – 5:00pm
Saturday 16 th March	9:00am – 11:00am and 3:00pm – 5:00pm
Sunday 17 th March	9:00am – 5:00pm

Tuesday 19 th March	9:00am – 11:00am and 3:00pm – 5:00pm
Wednesday 20 th March	9:00am – 5:00pm
Thursday 21 st March	9:00am – 1:00pm
Friday 22 nd March	9:00am – 1:00pm
Saturday 23 rd March	9:00am – 1:00pm
Sunday 24 th March	9:00am – 1:00pm

The nominated Coach or Team Manager will be made responsible for collection of all accreditation passes for their team. The responsible person will be required to present I.D. and sign for receipt of the accreditations. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** If the responsible person is not a coach that appears on the entry list or an individual for whom an additional accreditation request has been submitted, you will need to notify Rob Winkworth (rwinkworth@rowingaustralia.com.au) of the identity of this person a minimum of 24 hours before they collect the accreditations.

You will be required to wear and show these accreditation passes at all times to enter the venue from Monday 18th March onwards.

Individual athletes and coaches will not be able to collect their own accreditations. You should see your Team Manager to collect your individual accreditation.

Lost and found accreditation passes should be reported to the Accreditation Centre.

Replacement passes will incur a fee of \$40.

TEAM PARKING

Permits providing free car parking to teams competing in the SIRR will be issued based on the number of individuals entered, as outlined below:

Up to 20 entered individuals	1 x weekly parking permit
21 - 40 entered individuals	2 x weekly parking permits
41 - 60 entered individuals	3 x weekly parking permits
61 and over entered individuals	4 x weekly parking permits

ADDITIONAL TEAM & SPECTATOR PARKING

Any additional car parking tickets for teams or spectators may be purchased directly through Ticketek. Pre-purchase car parking tickets online is no longer possible as hard tickets will not be able to be posted and received prior to the regatta. Please note the following information regarding the purchasing of these tickets.

- You may pre-purchase parking tickets at any Ticketek outlet (in person)
- This arrangement applies up to and including event days

SPECTATOR TICKETING

Spectator ticketing information - NO TICKET OR TAG - NO ENTRY!

All spectators, families and friends of competitors at the Sydney International Rowing Regatta will require a ticket to enter the regatta venue on each day of the event. Tickets can only be purchased through Rowing Australia's ticketing partner, Ticketek, either online or via phone.

We recommend all spectators purchase their tickets in advance to reserve their Corporate or Grandstand seat and avoid queues at the regatta. To book tickets you can either:

ATHLETE PORTAL REMINDER

Each individual athlete and coach will need to complete the Athlete Portal process through RegattaCentral. Due to the legal nature of the Terms and Conditions, a parent or legal guardian will need to complete the process for athletes under the age of 18. The athlete portal is an online process which is optimized for mobile devices, but is also accessible via PC/Mac computers. The process should only take a few minutes to complete and will collect event contact information and other important details for each athlete and coach. Athletes that have not completed the portal process will not be allowed to compete at the SIRR.

1. Type the name of your Club or School then select it from the list
2. Select your role at the regatta (i.e. Athlete or Coach)
3. **Athletes** will need to enter their Last Name (Surname) and Birthdate and click **Next**;
Coaches will only need to enter their Last Name (Surname) and click **Next**
4. Select your record(s) and click **Next**
5. Complete your contact information and click **Next**
6. Agree to the all the Terms & Conditions and click **Next**
