**PRACTICE:** The course will be available for practice Wednesday, May 22 2-6pm and 2-6pm Thursday, May 23, 2019 weather permitting. Marshalls will only be provided during the posted times. Due to safety concerns, NO BOATS will be allowed on the water until the launch docks are cleared "OPEN". **Boats are not permitted to launch from the beach**.

## SHELLS: Trailers may be unloaded any time AFTER 12noon Wednesday, May 22, 2019

- Trailers will be permitted to move to storage area for unloading once rowers are on site.
- Teams have 30 minutes to unload and move shell trailer from the shell area. Once your equipment is unloaded, please move your trailer and tow unit to the shell trailer area. There are to be no unattended vehicles in the travel lanes. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Store boats in your assigned shell area only.
- Pop up tents are not permitted in the boat storage area.
- Trailers are not permitted on the lawn or beach area.
- Keep your boat area clean. Any team neglecting to maintain their site will be assessed a \$75.00 fee.

TENTS & CHUCKWAGONS: Chuckwagons may be unloaded any time AFTER 12noon Wednesday, May 22, 2019

- Set up your tent site within your assigned tent area. Tents, tables and chairs are not provided. Rental companies may set up any time after 12noon Wednesday.
- Staking of tents is permitted. Grills are permitted.
- Keep your tent area clean. Any team neglecting to maintain their site(s) will be assessed a \$75.00 charge.
- <u>Please move all trash to edge of the road</u>. Due to safety concerns, trash will not be picked up between tents. The LOC would appreciate all teams moving their trash to the roll-off containers near the tennis courts prior to departing from the park.
- Be aware that tent and food equipment will need to be carried to your site. Vehicle traffic of any kind other than designated regatta vehicles is not permitted on the grass or lanes down to the beach. Distance from drop off to tent site ranges from 50ft to 100yds. Wagons will be useful in moving heavier supplies.

#### **BUSES:**

- Have buses move to the designated loading/unloading area upon arrival as shown on the Regatta Map.
- Shuttle is available to and from regatta site by calling (740)565-9371
- Place Emergency Card (attached below) on the left side of windshield of the bus. This will help in case of an emergency.
- No buses are to park in the Camp Store Parking Lot
