\*\*IMPORTANT – There will be stake boats used. Please make sure all coxswains & crews know how to lock onto a stake boat and get a point. We will not allow for excessive delays due to the inability to lock on or get a point.

# PROGRESSION

- Stake boats will be used.
- There will be four buoy lines on the course outside lanes 1 and 6 and between lanes 2/3 and 4/5.
- Three or more entries are required to run an event.
- Events with six (6) or less entries final only.
- Events with two heats top 3 from each heat to final.
- Events with three heats top 2 from each heat to final.
- Events with four heats winner from each heat and next two fastest times.
- Events with five heats winner from each heat and next fastest time.
- Events with six heats winner from each heat.
- Varsity 8's will be seeded based on coaches poll.
- There will be a petite final for the Varsity 8's only.

# VOLUNTEERS

<u>All participating teams are asked to provide at least one volunteer for the regatta.</u> Additional volunteers will be much appreciated and allow for shorter shifts. T-shirts will be provided.

# **BOW NUMBERS**

Crews are responsible for providing their own bow numbers Bow numbers are REQUIRED for each boat.

#### SAFETY EQUIPMENT

All boats must have bow balls firmly attached and firmly tied heel ties on each set of shoes.

# MEDALS

Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place for fully subscribed events.

#### WEIGH-INS

Weigh-ins will not be conducted. Crews will be on the honor system. Lightweight Women – 130 lbs. maximum weight per rower, no boat average. Lightweight Men – 160 lbs. maximum weight per rower, 155 lbs. boat average.

Boats will not be weighed.

# FRIDAY PRACTICE HOURS/TRAFFIC PATTERN

If you choose to practice on Friday afternoon (3/28), be advised that a number of local crews will be also be on the River at that time and the course can get crowded. Please follow the traffic pattern below and use extreme caution.

- Traffic heading toward the start line must use lanes 0, 1 and 2 on the north side of the river.
- Traffic must turn counter clockwise direction (to port), crossing to the south side of the river.
- All traffic heading east toward the finish line must use lanes 4, 5, 6.
- Lane 3, the center of the river, will be an open safety lane.
- Rowing above the 130 bridges is prohibited due to construction.

# **TRAILERS & TENTS**

Per the Camden County Parks Dept, the parking lot on Cuthbert Blvd will be closed to trucks/trailers until 12:00PM on Friday, 3/28. <u>Please respect this request</u>. There will be a lot attendant on Friday to help enforce this request and maximize parking. All trucks parked in the lot will be issued a hang-tag on arrival. Only these vehicles will be allowed in the lot.

Team tents are not permitted to be set up prior to 4:00PM on Friday, 3/28 and no vehicles are permitted to drive on the grass by the viewing area. Please allow a 25-foot setback from the shore to allow for fair viewing for all spectators.

# Parking

- The trailer parking area is in the lot on the south side of North Park Drive near the launching docks.
  Only trailers are to be parked here.
- There is a large parking lot about the finish line for cars & vans and another 1,000-meter mark on the course.
- The curb area along North Park Drive between the small bridge and Cuthbert Blvd is for loading or unloading only. Others will be ticketed.
- <u>Team busses</u> are not permitted to park/idle on the street after dropping teams they should proceed to the Yacht Club parking lot across the river.
- Curbside parking is permitted in legal areas. Please observe all posted signs.
