

This email is mostly intended for teams bringing boats to the race this weekend and for those not familiar with getting to our boathouse(s).

The below directions are all to our Washington's Landing Boathouse which is where Race Headquarters will be (registration) and where all boat trailers and utility trailers will be going to. The address you can use for this boathouse is 300 Waterfront Dr., Pittsburgh, PA 15222. For those of you coming to Washington's Landing, please keep in mind that the entry onto the 31<sup>st</sup> Street Bridge is closed off Route 28. The below directions take this into account and take you ways that we find suitable with large boat trailers.

I will send out a detailed map of the island and the what each parking lot will be used for on Thursday.

## **TO WASHINGTON'S LANDING**

### **Coming from the east on 376W**

- Follow 376 into Pittsburgh
- Take exit 70c (right exit) to merge onto 279N, Ft Duquesne Bridge toward North Shore
- Once on the bridge move to far left for North Shore exit 1b
- Ramp merges into Reedsdale St, move immediately to left turn lane
- Turn left on Allegheny Ave (Heinz Field is on your left)
- At the end of Heinz Field, Allegheny Ave curves left and turns into North Shore Drive
- Follow North Shore Drive to Mazeroski Way (PNC Park directly in front of you)
- Turn left onto Mazeroski Way and immediately right onto W General Robinson
- Follow W General Robinson through 3 traffic lights
- After the 3<sup>rd</sup> light stay right to follow River Ave exit
- Follow River Ave to just before 31<sup>st</sup> Bridge at Stop sign
- Turn right to take ramp to Washington's Landing
- At end of ramp follow road around to left this is Waterfront Dr look for parking volunteer

### **Coming from the south and west on 376E (formerly 279N)**

- Follow 376E through Fort Pitt Tunnel
- Tunnel exits onto Ft Pitt Bridge, move to left lane follow signs for 279N, 65N, North Shore
- Travel across Ft Duquesne Bridge and move to left lane to follow exit for North Shore 1b
- Ramp merges into Reedsdale St, move immediately to left turn lane
- Turn left on Allegheny Ave (Heinz Field is on your left)
- At the end of Heinz Field, Allegheny Ave curves left and turns into North Shore Drive
- Follow North Shore Drive to Mazeroski Way (PNC Park directly in front of you)
- Turn left onto Mazeroski Way and immediately right onto W General Robinson
- Follow W General Robinson through 3 traffic lights
- After the 3<sup>rd</sup> light (Anderson St) stay right to follow River Ave exit
- Follow River Ave to just before 31<sup>st</sup> Bridge at Stop sign
- Turn right to take ramp to Washington's Landing

- At end of ramp follow road around to left this is Waterfront Dr look for parking volunteer

### **Coming from the north on 28S**

- Follow 28S (there is a lot of construction near the 40<sup>th</sup> St and 31<sup>st</sup> St Bridges, also there is no access to the 31<sup>st</sup> St Bridge from Route 28)
- As you leave construction area stay to left on 28 DO NOT take East Ohio St, Chestnut St exit
- Just past E Ohio St, Chestnut St exit follow sign for 279S
- Follow 279S for very short distance to North Shore 1b exit
- North Shore exit ramp to Reedsdale St
- Move to left lane immediately to turn left on Tony Dorsett
- Again stay left to immediately turn left onto W General Robinson
- Follow W General Robinson through 4 traffic lights
- After the 4th light (Anderson St) stay right to follow River Ave exit
- Follow River Ave to just before 31<sup>st</sup> Bridge at Stop sign
- Turn right to take ramp to Washington's Landing
- At end of ramp follow road around to left this is Waterfront Dr look for parking volunteer
