

Team Tents:

Due to the large request for team tent space for the Southeast District Youth Championship Regatta, Oak Ridge Rowing will assign spaces in the order in which reservations and payment are received. Each team will be allowed a space 20 feet wide and may vary in depth within the Team Tent Area. Teams needing more space will be required to purchase an additional tent space. ALL of team tent spaces are within walking distance to boat trailers, parking, vendors and waterfront. Teams must check in prior to tent placement. Teams can be reserve spaces by submitting a completed reservation form on regattacentral.com. All team tents supplied by Oak Ridge Rowing in this area will be installed on Friday prior to the event

Teams will be allowed to unload vehicles in the unloading area near the team tent area between 12:00 PM and 8:00 PM on Friday, May 3, 2013.

Teams are not permitted to set up tents or awnings over open flame unless the tent meets fire safety standards. Teams are required to have a fire extinguisher in their cooking area. Extinguish all flames before leaving your area. Cooking is limited to gas grills only. Use of charcoal is prohibited. Grills should be set up away from, or protected from, pedestrian traffic and flammable materials. Grills must be monitored at all times. Do not dump cooking oil on the venue.

No electricity will be provided for team tents. Gasoline-powered generators are strictly prohibited; they create noise and carbon dioxide fumes that are disturbing and harmful to others.

The use of spikes or stakes to secure your tent is prohibited anywhere on the venue. Electrocution is a potential hazard due to high power lines are buried all along the venue. Sandbags or other dead weight are permitted, but please do NOT dump the sand out onto in the grass area.

Please do not block sidewalks or entrances/exits to buildings with tailgating supplies and tents.

No sound systems utilizing loud amplification or soundboards will be allowed on the venue. No excessive loud music will be allowed. The Regatta Staff will have sole discretion in determining if the overall volume level of other sound systems is appropriate.

No vehicles or booster trailers will be allowed on the grass.
